Letter from Board Chair

2018 - 2019 was a productive year. The Board and RISE staff worked extremely hard to positively advance our financial position.

The Board Executive Committee has been working on RISE's new policy manual, ensuring it aligns with changes to government policies and industry best practices.



We had the opportunity to move within our current

location to an office that is much larger and has an open concept. This will help RISE to advance client services and better meet their needs without incurring any additional cost. We take our hats off to our staff and volunteers, who accomplished the move within a very tight timeframe and without any technical or logistic problems.

RISE introduced Community Canvas Paint Night last year and since then it has grown and flourished by leaps and bounds. It now has an attendance of approximately 25 people on a regular basis and is known within the broader community as a fun and enjoyable night out. Not only have the attendees supported this event but many of them continue to show their support by becoming RISE members.

Coffee Break newsletter is in its 11th year and continues to provide a bi-monthly outreach to the community. It has become a very welcomed communication piece within the Parry Sound area. We consistently receive positive feedback regarding the content and how much our recipients anticipate receiving each addition.

We look forward to continued growth and the advancement of Independent Living throughout the Parry Sound and Muskoka Districts.

Letter from Secretary/Treasurer

I have been the Secretary/Treasurer of RISE for 3 years. This past year has been a stressful time not knowing whether

federal funding was going to come through for RISE. IL Canada approved funding for a part of the fiscal year;
Apr. 1/18 – Sept. 30/18. In the latter part of the fall, they announced funding for the balance of the year;
Oct. 1/18 – Mar. 31/19. Our Executive Director, Tammy Gould, submitted a Letter of Support to IL Canada for additional funding. Although our CORE funding from the federal government has decreased this year, IL Canada was able to secure the CORE funding for the next 3 years; 2019 – 2022.



The Direct Funding Program did not see an expansion this year; 2019-2020 due to lack of provincial funding. But, CILT did increase the incentive funding for the number of people who started on the Direct Funding Program, so even with these changes to the funding we are still able to continue with our operations. With the decrease in funding we have been looking at new ways of creating resources for keeping our cash flow up. As a team, the Executive Director, Bookkeeper and the Board collectively managed to get through our troubled year.

We are into our 11th year now of the Coffee Break Newsletters. Feedback has been wonderful with people expressing interest and enjoyment from reading these newsletters. We have been securing more ads and renewing existing ones which benefits RISE and its programs.

The Community Canvas event is in its second year now and is a big hit in the community as more people are coming out and bringing family and friends. In January 2019, RISE went in a different direction in that instead of a \$15 ticket, prices changed to \$15 for a member or \$25 for a non-member. January's Community Canvas as cancelled due to inclement weather. Everyone who had prepaid for January used those funds for February. By March, we saw a significant change. RISE acquired 14 new memberships.

We also have a few more fundraising events scheduled for the upcoming year. We are looking forward to the Parking Meter Initiative from the Town of Parry Sound. Last year, RISE was approved to receive the funds raised in the parking meters around town. The Downtown Business Association presented RISE with a cheque for \$192.10 for the time period of Jan. 1/18 – Mar. 31/18. The DBA has changed the time frame this year to allow for more businesses to become involved. RISE has been lucky this year; we are designated the time period of July 1-31, 2019; the height of tourist season.

Gingrich and Harris are our auditors again. They provided us a draft when the audit was completed after last year's AGM. The Audit Summary is available at the office if you wish a copy. Please contact Tammy and let her know and she will get one off to you. Gingrich has been acquired for the next 2 fiscal years; April 1, 2018 - March 31, 2019 and April 1, 2019 – March 31, 2020 to conduct an Engagement Review. The cost of this Review will be significantly lower than an audit which will benefit RISE in the future.

Once again everyone is encouraged to renew their memberships to be able to vote at the AGM. Membership applications are available.

Letter from Executive Director



2018 has been a very tough year, financially, for RISE. With everyone at the helm working diligently on the issue, we have streamlined our expenses and very slowly started seeing a comeback.

I was off for a short period of time recouping from a right knee replacement.

The Self-Managed Attendant Services - Direct Funding Program continues to be our flagship program for RISE. I was out of the office quite a bit with DF presentations, health fairs, information forums, and community presentations in bringing awareness to the community. As the Direct Funding Program Coordinator, I assist consumers with completing their applications, review their daily schedules, assist with interview preparation, panel interviews, assist with advertisements for attendants, hiring process, provide support to self-mangers, assist with budget increase requests, and so much more!

Trying to manage this around the daily office routines can be challenging but the rewards are awesome!

Independent Living Across Canada Day was celebrated on June 4, 2018.

RISE was awarded their 5-year accreditation certificate at the September 2018 IL Canada AGM in Ottawa.

RISE was incorporated in 1998 thus marking it's 20-year anniversary. To celebrate 20 years of service to the community, we coincided this with International Day of Disabled Persons on December 3, 2018 with an Open House. Guests and consumers attended and enjoyed the refreshments!

We continue to come up with different fundraising ideas. Some of the ideas that came to fruition or continue to flourish include: The Shoe Drive, StopGap Parry Sound, Parking Meter Initiative, Community Canvas Paint Night, and Sit & Get Fit Adaptive/Inclusive Yoga.

RISE consistently looks for ways to seek and obtain ongoing funding by broadening our revenue base and exploring new initiatives, increasing awareness of programs and services, evaluating services and what makes them unique from other organizations, and increasing the overall knowledge base and personal growth through development opportunities such as self-improvement programs, workshops, training, and networking with other agencies.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank Tabitha Stapleton, Bookkeeper/Admin Support. She is the backbone of RISE and for me. She looks after our financials and is very knowledgeable with community agencies, the general public, past events, fundraising, and the day-to-day operations of the organization.

And a big "thank you" to the Board of Directors who have really stepped up this year and supported RISE.
